

Agatha Prator Grants (2023-2025) Information

Application for the *Agatha Prator Grant* will be accepted for the spring semester (applications due November 1) **and** for the fall semester (applications due April 1). **All material** must be sent **in one email** to the email address on the application. If internet options are not available for an extended time the applicant may call and make other arrangements.

Please distribute a copy of the proposed guidelines as well as the application form to any prospective applicant.

1. The Agatha Prator Grant, to be paid from proceeds from the Prator Trust, will be awarded annually to a pre-service teacher enrolled in an institution of higher education who is an Arkansas resident (or a resident of Texarkana, TX) **enrolled in the student teaching experience** (either as a senior or as an intern).
2. Applicants must be students in good standing at an institution of higher education which is NCATE approved, must have been admitted to the teacher education program, and must be within one semester of the student teaching experience. This grant is for a semester during which the recipient is student teaching or interning.
3. Applicants must meet reasonable standards as far as grant requirements, leadership potential, and other evidence of potential for future service to the education profession.
4. The amount of the grant is \$2500 and will be credited to recipient's school account.
5. The applicant must provide on the application the date of the semester he/she will be enrolled in the student teaching experience and the location of the student teaching assignment, as far as he/she knows.
6. The Grant award will be made upon the recipient's verification of enrollment in the student teaching semester.
7. The recipient shall become actively employed in the educational field within two years of receiving the Grant award. In event of non-compliance, the Grant becomes a loan, and funds shall be returned to Arkansas State Organization. Any awards subject to return must be repaid within the next two years (i.e., the deadline for repayment would be four calendar years from the date of the award). Documentation of employment in the education field shall be emailed to the Arkansas State Organization Scholarship Committee Chair, **Elizabeth Tye**, elizabethtye2018@gmail.com, the Arkansas State Organization Treasurer, or the Arkansas State Organization President. The recipient will return an **Acceptance Agreement** before the \$2500 can be accredited to her tuition account.
